I. PTP Roll Call: Start time 3:00 p.m. Melinda Boyd, Cheryl Marple, Christy Howell, Marlene Fune and Shannon Meyers

II. Approval of Prior Minutes: Melinda makes a motion to approve the April 30 minutes and Shannon seconds the motion.

III. Action Items:

A. Open House May 23, 5:30 - 6:45 p.m. Hot dogs will be served this year, and will be boiled in roaster pans instead of using a BBQ. Shannon will purchase from Costco the following supplies: 350 hot dogs, 350 buns, (2) 3-packs of condiments which include catsup, mustard and relish in squeeze bottles, about 350 bottles of water, 300 mini individual bags of chips. The PTP refrigerator still has several cans of soda and spritzers. The hot dogs will be "donation only" and the chips, water, and spritzers will be sold for \$1 each. School candy bars will be sold for \$1 each, and items for the dessert buffet will be free. Shannon will also bring cash for the cash box, allowing us to have enough change to start with. Shannon and Melinda will help set up prior to Open House.

B. Spring Concert May 23, 7-8 p.m. - Spring Concert will be held indoors this year, in the multi-purpose room. Hot dogs will be prepared and served from the cafeteria kitchen. Beth's aftercare kids will be glad to decorate the donation jar.

C. Teacher's Dinner - Dinner from Tres Hombres will be available to the teachers prior to the Open House. Cheryl will call Kari Brose to make arrangements. Meanwhile, Christy H. will check with the new restaurant in Forest Ranch to see if they'd be available for catering future teacher meals.

D. Yearbook - Christy's yearbook donation envelopes: Christy will talk with Terry about sending an email reminding parents to pick up envelopes at the front desk if they need one.

E. T-Shirts - The 6th graders will be having a get together on Tuesday, June 4th and will need their t-shirts on that day. Shannon will contact Darrell from Positive Print to arrange for t-shirt pick up. Scrapbook, sharpie pens and frames have been purchased for the 6h graders for their t-shirt signing day. Shannon placed an order at Costco for the 6th grade graduation cake. Christy H. will pick up the cake on June 3rd. White cake with white frosting, with FRCS Class of 2013 written on it, a blue graduation cap and colorful flowers on top. Marlene makes a motion to spend \$75-100 on the 6th grade party (for pizza, cake and gifts) and Cheryl seconds the motion.

6th Grade shirts: These shirts will be given to the 6th graders, allowing them to have their classmates sign their shirts during the last week of school. We'll order 10 adult medium, 20 adult large, and 10 adult XL, which will be enough for 2013 and 2014.

Total 6th grade shirts: 40 at \$6.00 each. Heather grey.

F. Silver Dollar Fair - Christy H. wants to remember to pick up tabs from the Silver Dollar Fair 3 days prior to delivering the artwork. This step would save time, since each tab has the child's name on it, and the tab gets stapled on to the background/border of each art project.

G. Ideas for fundraisers - Marlene mentioned that the Firewood Fundraiser has officially started in front of the Forest Ranch store. Pine firewood bundles are available for a donation.

H. Path Of Success -On June 1 Richard would like to do the final pouring of concrete. Christy will contact Rich to confirm that date, and will contact 2 other parents. Christy has plastic to protect the bricks while the concrete is being poured. Plastic must be taped on to path of success before the concrete is poured...either this weekend or the weekend of June 1st, depending on what Richard's plans are. Melinda makes a motion that we provide food for the work party and Marlene seconds the motion. We're on track for the Path of Success budget.
