We are very pleased to announce that the FRCS students who took the STAR test last spring did a great job. The scores from the STAR test are used to calculate the Academic Performance Index (API), the bar by which the state and federal governments measure the success of schools. Our API increased from 843 to 846, putting FRCS ranked fourth highest in the district.
