

FRCS P.T.P. MEETING

I. PTP Roll Call: Start time 3:00 p.m. In attendance: Melinda Boyd, Marlene Fune, Christy Howell, Michelle Jimenez, and Shannon Meyers.

II. Melinda makes a motion to approve the March 8, 2016 minutes and Shannon seconds the motion.

III. Action Items:

- A. Financial Report – Chocolate bar sales are still coming in, with estimated profit in a few months. Yearbook donations totaled approximately \$1,055 so far. We'll order 20 for teachers and board members, and more to have on hand for extra last-minute sales. (This number is decided based on ½ of the number of yearbooks not ordered by parents). Current total in PTP account: \$7,715.
- B. Jump & Jog-a-Thon – Marlene will set up cones and tracks. Shade structures will not be assembled this year. Shannon will pick up the snacks and help distribute them. This year, we'll serve frozen go-gurt tubes, which can be cut and served ½ at a time. Oranges, and goldfish crackers will also be available. Christy will get cups and water jugs.
- C. Garden project: Marlene got cedar logs milled at Kenny Rawe's which will be used for making garden boxes. This cost \$140 for milling fee (\$70 per hour). Shannon makes a motion that PTP covers cost of Kenny's milling fee for garden boxes and Melinda seconds the motion. We'll discuss drinking fountains at a future meeting.
- D. Earth Day – April 22nd – In years past, each teacher has an activity. Christy makes a motion for up to \$200 to pay for Ron's Reptiles and Shannon seconds the motion.
- E. Egg Drop – April 29th – Fire Engine at about 1:30 p.m. Marlene to arrange this. The 6-8th graders will engineer a device that catches the egg, while younger grades will design a container to keep their egg safe when it is dropped.

- F. Sock Hop – This event may not happen this year.
- G. Spaghetti/Bingo Night – May 21st. Volunteers needed.
- H. Graduation t-shirts (grey) – We currently have 3 medium, 11 large, and 1 extra-large in the PTP closet. More will have to be ordered. Picture frames for 8th graders was discussed, along with idea of photo of the students taken possibly in Monterey.
- I. Open House – May 19th – Pizza was sold last year, along with chocolate bars, fruit and water. Jason Beaudry will make food for the teacher’s dinner.
- J. Spring Concert – May 19th – will be at 7:15 p.m. Christy and Michelle discussed timing and organization for classes at the concert.
- K. Speakers for Chrono books - \$23 for speakers. Videos for kids, need speakers for small groups in the classrooms. Marlene makes a motion for Christy to research and purchase speakers up to \$100 and Shannon seconds the motion.
- L. Silver Dollar Fair – student art due May 20th.

- A. Christy mentioned the need for small walkie talkies. Marlene recommended asking Lisa Speegle about them. The school may have a facilities fund for this.
