

FRCS P.T.P. MEETING

Minutes

- I. PTP Roll Call: Start time 3:00 p.m. In attendance: Melinda Boyd, Marlene Fune, Michelle Jimenez, Theresa Palmarini, Monica Rogers, Lisa Speegle and Shannon Meyers.
- II. Melinda makes a motion to approve the Dec. 08, 2015 minutes and Michelle seconds the motion.
- III. Action Items:
 - A. Financial Report – General fund, July – December shows a profit of \$1054. Current funds are at about \$8,000.
 - B. Path of Success – Moved to future meeting when Christy and Cheryl can attend. Cheryl's notes indicate that PTP has about \$1500 left over from the Path of Success fundraiser. We should discuss how much it will cost to build a shade structure, how much can PTP contribute, and determine the priority of this project.
 - C. Teacher classroom budget - \$100 was approved in September 2015. Re-evaluate budget for the classrooms. Mr. Connors has extra science projects. Marlene makes a motion to give each teacher \$100 for classroom supplies from January through June 2016, allowing a transfer of \$800, and Shannon seconds the motion.
 - D. Winter Concert Recap – A total of \$662 was raised for raffle basket sales, and \$51 was raised from the cocoa & cider table. We discussed using walky-talkies next year, to improve communication required for bringing the classrooms to the MPR to sing.
 - E. Sweatshirt/t-shirt order – Save for next month's agenda.
 - F. Yearbook – The letter with a pre-order form will be sent out in January by Christy, and Lisa Speegle would like information to be included in the newsletter.
 - G. Student Government – January 29th is Crazy Hair Day. Students made \$92 during the Multicultural Night bake sale to raise funds for the Butte County Humane Society. Mrs. Jimenez mentioned the possibility of not doing the bake sale next year during

Multi-Cultural Night. The Running Club (grades 4 – 8) will begin on January 20th. The Running Club will be coached by Kevin, who is researching runs in Chico. Student Government is gearing up for the jog-a-thon, which will be on April 15th.

- H. Bingo Night – We need to pick a night for this event, and find out which night Christia chooses for the school play. Lisa Speegle will double check on special rules, if any, for Bingo Night. Discussed whether we have any Bingo game pieces. We'll designate April 2nd until we determine when the school play is. The Jr. High would like to have a Valentine's Day Dance.

IV. Information and Discussion Items:

- A. Forest Ranch Post – Information must be in by the 25th of the month to make it into the Post.
- B. FRCS Play – Alice in Wonderland Jr. will be performed the third weekend in April.
- C. Discussed new backdrop ideas for the Winter Concert backdrop. The one we've had for years (made of thin plastic) has become worn & torn to re-use any longer. It measured 12' x 25 or 30'. A new one can be fortified with similarly colored duct tape & grommets.
