III. Action Items:

- A. Music Festival, May 31st. Class donations will be available for silent auction: a framed picture and a scarf crocheted by Mrs. Stearns class, a flag made by Mrs. DJ's class from the Age of Sales field trip, books made by Mrs. Palmarini's class, and photo posters from Sutter's fort from Mrs. McNulty's and Lisa Matoes's class. Christy will send an email with a list of classroom items being auctioned during the Music Festival. Free passes available for teachers and family. Activities will be available for kids in the multi-purpose room, not in classrooms or the rest of the school. Posters will be displayed with schedules for bands and events. Friday night is Camp-Out Night with dinner for families helping to set up the Music Festival. Kids must be signed to an adult during this time. There will be a small auction on Friday, depending on how many people are there. Two cash boxes will be on hand for the raffle and food court. Lisa Speegle will be gathering money and will do a double count of money at the end of the event. The Lions Club will be in charge of their own cash box at the gate and will give FRCS a check.
