II. Approval of prior minutes –Marlene makes a motion to approve the Sept. 23, 2014 minutes and Melinda seconds the motion.

III. Action Items:

- A. Full Moon Festival – Bottled water left for festival. Wellness standards, evening event. Water, lemonade, iced tea, hot cocoa and coffee will be available for \$1 per cup. Pizza will be sold at \$2 slice, as well as Lundberg chips, Selby honey sticks, and fundraiser chocolate bars. We have plenty of cups and possibly lids. Marlene will double check. We need 3 or 4 cases of water from Costco, and gloves for handling the food. Christy will get the smaller cups for kids and will check on the small one-click flashlights. Cheryl can help in the kitchen with Shannon. Melinda will talk to Cheryl about cooking the pizza. Helpers for set up include Jamie Solomon and Janina. We'll begin Saturday at 11 a.m. There will be a haunted house, musical chairs, limbo, dancing, crafts, and a fortune teller. Shannon will bring cash for the cash box. We have enough paper plates in the PTP closet. There will be small goodie bags and prizes for games. The cake walk will feature a choice of cupcakes as prizes for books for the kids. Lisa mentions the idea of having the Full Moon Festival on a day after school next year? A definite possibility.
- B. Kleen Kanteen – The Kleen Kanteen 16 oz. bottles plus pop-top lids cost us \$10 each. We'll sell them for \$15 along with the two stickers. One sticker features the FRCS logo with a white space for writing a name on it. The other sticker is smaller, with information about how important it is to drink plenty of water. There are 100 extra stickers that can be sold separately for \$2 each, so that kids can personalize their other water bottles.

- C. Chocolate Bars – They just came in and will be sold for \$2 at the Full Moon Festival.
- D. Burrito Update – About \$1800 was raised, with expenses totaling \$300. Profits will be divided between the Community Center and Trinity. Monday is from the FRCS kids for Trinity, raised by parents. FRCS kids can present a check to Trinity and she can decide what she wants to spend it on.
